## HOLSTEIN COW AND HEIFER TAKE SUPREME AT PREMIER NATIONAL JUNIOR SHOWS

Youth from 33 States take the Ring in the Nation's only Exclusively Junior Exhibitor Show

**Harrisburg, Pa. (Sept. 16, 2025)** - The Premier National Junior Show was held Sept. 15 at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, Pa., in conjunction with the All-American Dairy Show. In one day, nearly 1,000 animals representing all seven breeds and junior exhibitors from 33 states competed in the nation's only exclusively junior exhibitor show.

The Supreme Champion Cow was the winning aged Holstein, Oakfield Tatoo Tender-ET (Tatoo), exhibited by Chloe and Claire Lamb of Oakfield, Ny.

Supreme Champion Bred and Owned was the winning five-year-old Brown Swiss, Colebrook Creek Dt Alina (Dynamite), exhibited by Abigail Wilber of New Hartford, CT.

Lastly, the Supreme Junior Champion was the winning winter calf Holstein, Peace&Plenty Archit Jubi182 (Architect) exhibited by Bryn Vidler of Tully, NY.
